

Bulk Trash Zones



Place bulk trash at the curb by 5am the day of collection or no sooner than 6 pm the night before.

Bulk trash must be placed at least 5 feet from your garbage container and away from other obstructions including gas & water meters, mailboxes, vehicles, etc.

Yard and tree trimmings must be cut to a size up to 4' x 6' and separated from other Bulk Trash items.

Yard waste such as grass clippings, brush & leaves must be bagged. Bagged yard waste may also be placed in your garbage container, roll-off bin or drop them off at the Public Works Yd. 355 S 1st St. 7am to 1pm Mon. thru Fri. (except holidays)

Large item disposal: (furniture/appliances) Reserve an 8 yd, roll-off bin or drop them off at the Public Works Yard, 7am to 1pm Mon. thru Fri.

MONDAY, MAY 30, 2016: MEMORIAL DAY

Monday's trash pickup day will move to Tuesday and Tuesday's pickup day will move to Wednesday

MONDAY, JULY 4, 2016: INDEPENDENCE DAY

Monday's trash pickup day will move to Tuesday and Tuesday's pickup day will move to Wednesday

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 5, 2016: LABOR DAY

Monday's trash pickup day will move to Tuesday and Tuesday's pickup day will move to Wednesday

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2016: VETERANS' DAY

Thursday's trash-pickup day will move to Wednesday and Friday's pickup day will move to Thursday

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2016: THANKSGIVING DAY

Thursday's trash pickup day will move to Wednesday and there will be regular trash pickup on Friday

COOLIDGE LIQUID WASTE FACTS & FIGURES:

Our Wastewater Treatment Plant is staffed by 3 full time employees;

The Plant Supervisor and 2 Plant Operators

All our WWTP employees are level Class III or IV operators

They are responsible for:

3, 487 Residential accounts & 194 Commercial accounts

1.35 million gallons per day of lagoon type wastewater

Maintenance and repair of approximately 73 miles of wastewater collection lines

Maintenance and repair of over 1027 manholes

Maintenance of 8 lift stations in conjunction with forced mains

Operation of the WWTP in accordance with all State & Federal regulations and requirements

Responding to blockages in mainlines & other related problems within the Wastewater

Collection system (excluding lines within the homeowner's lot)


ROLL-OFF BIN POLICY

The roll-off bins are delivered to the scheduled addresses by 2:00pm in the afternoon and are picked up the following morning of our normally scheduled work day.

Once delivered the roll-off *will not* be moved and remains where placed until picked up.

If the roll-off is requested to be placed within a locked location, the gate must be open and/or unlocked by 5:00am on the day of delivery and on the scheduled date for pickup.

You must also be current on your sewer and trash account to use this free service.



The following items cannot be disposed of in the roll-off bin:

Anything that would pose a hazard to ourselves or our community including:

Household garbage; Construction debris and building/remodeling materials such as lumber, shingles, dirt, rock, stone, tile, brick, cement and/or concrete material.

Hazardous, industrial, medical or radioactive materials, chemical by-products, paint, insecticides and/or herbicides and potentially environmentally destructive materials.

Automotive parts: motors, transmissions, batteries, tires, fuel tanks or cans, used oil.
