- C.A.S.P.E.R. is held at Heartland School and West School, Monday thru Thursday. *Children whom regularly attend the program from 3:15-4:30 pm, will be charged \$1 per hour. (This must be pre-arranged with the C.A.S.P.E.R. Coordinator). **Subsidies for child care are available through the Department of Economic Security to eligible families.
