Chairwoman Vicki Williams, called the meeting to order at 6:03 pm. **Board members present were, Tori Carrasco, Tony Garcia, Anthony Moore and Vicki Williams. Board Members absent were, Gabe Garcia, Anthony Felix and Steve Brokeshoulder.** Staff members present were Ricky LaPaglia, Parks and Recreation Director, and Mary Rascon, Secretary.

MINUTE APPROVAL

Anthony Moore made a motion to accept the minutes as written, seconded by Tony Garcia, passed unanimously.

Parks & Recreation Director's Report

Ricky LaPaglia, Parks and Recreation Director reported on the following programs.

C.A.S.P.E.R. is now at full capacity. There are 15-18 that go daily. C.A.S.P.E.R. will end for the summer next week.

The adult softball league went very well with eight Co-Ed and eight Men's teams. Adult Volleyball had six teams.

T-Ball league ended last week. This year we had a record number of kids. There were 121 registered for the league, next year will need to add more teams.

Gym dedication for Tyron was held in March. Wall mural was painted by Ann Mitchell and. Dedication went well.

Aerobics class is going; there are 20-25, participants in the aerobics program

The Youth Center is open Monday thru Friday 3-6 pm. Summer hours will start, May 29, we will open 10 am-6 pm. We will see how it works with these hours, if we do not have enough participation with early hours; we will look at opening later.

Little League is currently going at Kenilworth Sports complex, so we decided not to hold Adult softball games until in the fall.

Ricky LaPaglia, introduced Tori Carrasco, new boardmember. Boardmembers welcomed Tori to the Board.

Scholarship for Kids Kamp

Indian Skies donated \$1500 for the summer Kids Kamp program. There is enough for about twenty kids. Ricky said that if they did not receive more participants they would let kids go for a second session. Boardmembers do not need to take action on this because there are not that many letters. Letters will be sent to boardmembers as they get more.

Summer Programs

The first session of Summer Kids Kamp program will start on June 4. Kids Kamp is a two week session that goes from 7:30 am-5:30 pm. Kids have breakfast, lunch and a snack that is offered through the Coolidge School District.

Repairs on the pool have started; they will be working on the roof and resurfacing the diving boards. Hope to have it done before summer classes and swim starts.

Swimming lessons will be Monday-Friday, 9-11 am. Open swim will be from 1:00-5:00 pm, Tuesday-Sunday, and Wednesday, 7:00-9:00 pm
