Planning for the Future...



Did you know?

The City of Coolidge recently applied for and received funding from the Arizona Department of Transportation's (ADOT) Planning Assistance for Rural Areas (PARA) program to study the current transportation system in Coolidge.

The City and ADOT are collaborating on the City of Coolidge Comprehensive Transportation Feasibility Plan to see what is working and what isn't—to develop a plan for future growth.

The study will look at the entire transportation system in Coolidge, including bicycle, pedestrian, vehicle and other travel modes. By examining the existing system and future needed improvements, the team can identify future connections to major regional roadways and also plan a multimodal transit and trail system for the community.

When?

The study is kicking off in **summer 2011** and will last about a year. Watch for more information about the first public meeting this fall.
