
FREE SCHEDULE

- C.A.S.P.E.R. is held at Heartland School and West School, Monday thru Thursday.

*Children whom regularly attend the program from 3:15-4:30 pm, will be charged \$1 per hour. (This must be pre-arranged with the C.A.S.P.E.R. Coordinator). **Subsidies for child care are available through the Department of Economic Security to eligible families. Qualifications are based on gross income, family size, and employment situation. To determine if you are eligible to receive a child care subsidy please contact:


