15.1 Long term planning

As resources permit, the Department should develop a multi-year plan which establishes long-term goals and objectives in light of projected population and development trends, local resources and long-term capital needs.

15.2 Goals and objectives

Established agency goals and objectives should be both measurable and measured, and should be communicated throughout the agency to all employees. The attainment of goals and objectives should be reviewed annually and the plan updated as necessary.

15.3 Crime Analysis

Crime analysis, including the collection, collation, analysis and dissemination of data related to local criminal activity is the responsibility of the Police Crime Analyst. All such reports shall be forwarded through the chain of command to the Chief.
