

NOTICE OF SPECIAL BOND MAIL BALLOT ELECTION

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-228(C), public notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Coolidge has called a special bond election to held by mail ballot in and for the City on November 5, 2019.

1. **Date of the Election.**

The special election will be conducted in the City on November 5, 2019. The special election will be conducted by mail and no polling places will be provided.

2. **Qualifications of Electors**

A voter in this special election must be a qualified elector of the City. A qualified elector of the City is defined as a person who is registered to vote and whose name appears on the Pinal County voter register rolls within the boundaries of the City twenty-nine (29) days prior to the date of election, which is October 7, 2019.

3. **Date Ballots Will be Mailed to Qualified Electors.**

Start date for mailing of ballots is October 9th, 2019.

4. **Deadline and Location for Return of the Ballots.**

Ballots must be received by the Pinal County Recorder's Office or Elections Department by 7:00 p.m. on November 5, 2019.

5. **Method for Obtaining a Replacement if a Ballot Is Destroyed, Lost, Spoiled or Not Received.**
